VI. Special Presentations

- a. AVP College Affairs, Leonard Bobbitt on Election Bylaws
Submitted by Kristian Castro
 - Courtney Hill –Advocate General – now head of elections □osse
 - from AS
 - new election code passed 3 weeks ago
 - Big changes in election code

- One rep from each college (but no part in A.S. elections)
- College councils now responsible for own polls (A.S. not involved)
- Trying to extend filing time for candidacy – 2 weeks added
- A.S. senators now need 50 sigs
- Slates now institutionalized – can carry over from year to year – file one A.S. page online
 - o Can designate someone to carry over if choose
 - o Slate names on first come first serve basis
- Campaign conduct rules
 - o Campaigning and slate building activities differentiated and defined
 - o Gave each rule a recommended sanction
- Campaign finance
 - o Have total cap - \$3,400
 - o Weekly finance meeting held by Advocate General
- Parminder motioned to extend 10 min – Sabrien 2nded
- Enforcement of conduct code
 - o “Grievance” changed to “complaint”
 - o No more student vs. student or slate vs. slate
 - o Election committee provides sanction recommendations
 - o Judicial board separate from elections
- Appeals
 - o Judicial board used to be “2nd opinion”- not anymore
 - o Now have appeals board – made up of judicial boards from college councils
- College councils
 - o Still run on A.S. ballot – but A.S. not involved in college election disputes
- By week 7 want all college councils to talk about election codes
- Sabrien: if want to sit on election □osse. – can you run in college council as rep? -yes

b. Student Conduct Code Workgroup

Tony , Jason and Martin from Muir

Committee Appointed by penny rue

- Parm: (current) too legalistic, specific – too difficult to understand
- Current: like textbook ☹ - goal to make conduct code more accessible/easier to understand
- Community standards – not juss students, but faculty and staff
- 2006 survey every 4 year – student satisfaction at all Ucs – not happy with conduct process
- Committee in 2009 to fix conduct code – fac/staff/students in □osse.
- Chair = director of career center – vc of experimental learning – “keeps corralled” outside part
- Presenting key changes
- Now just jumps in rules/reg – but want to set a tone first – description – need intro! Now doesn’t have any – 3 paragraphs of intro
- Old :Mainly deals with one campus – new: tried to address more off campus issues/incidents
- Ex. Compton cookout – if broader would be dealt with diff way or how to deal w/ m.i.p.= minor in □ossession

- Old: demanding – specific way to react to certain situation new: spent hours changing language/words – and explanations included instead of “do not do” list
- New: took out extraneous words – more concise/easier to read/less legalistic – no numbers (22.16.10.31 – instead simple 1,2,3...system)
- Diff boards student meet with – old: not enough option with how issue to be resolves
- Old: longggg – new: SCA – student conduct admin – res dean/dean/person who gets report of misconduct
 - o Do we really need to act on?
 - No – warning/non disciplinary action
 - Yes – is student at risk from being separated from university?
 - Yes – student chooses board review
 - No – board review – SCA chooses
 - o If bigger issue – go to board of peers – have chance of more option (to not feel one person decided their fate)
 - o At end of each - can appeal
 - o Made mirror process for grads/professionals
 - One dean for entire grad – one assistant dean
 - o Student orgs- if principal member = principally responsible
 - Individually sanctioned and also as a group sanctioned
 - o Last person to hear appeals = provost
- Old: no specific place for records – new: office of student conduct =custodian for disciplinary records
- How long should record be kept? – possibility of record being voided (ex. If applying to grad school)
- **Revisedcode.ucsd.edu** – anonymous feedback/questions/comments
 - o All comments and feedback read/looked at and discussed at length – important!
- Parminder motion to extend time – jasmine second
- Parminder: student did something wrong that is not directly related to university in old way – but now more realm to play
 - o Tony: do you want actions of your peers to affect your degree?
 - o Think about UCSB rep
- What do you want ideal UCSD student to represent?
- Narciso: tested for language or content independently? Reasons pinpointed?
 - o Yes – specific problems pointed out – but passes that stage now
- Feedback >> more liberal

c. Fall Revised Budget

- Activity fee increased 5 cents
- 30,000 carry over from last year
- Everything on this budget based on post-budget from last year
- Student initiative set at \$1000
- Senator project line item added at \$3000
- VPC lecture series line itemed \$1000

- GU now at \$12,921 – higher than it’s ever been (compared to 8,500 last year)
