b. Diversity and Sustainability Advocate Positions

- new branch of SCSC, attend bi-weekly council meeting, non-voting, have one big project during term, working under president
- diversity: gender, culture, race, ethnicity, nationality, sexual orientation
 - cross-cultural, LGBT, women's center
- sustainability: "meeting needs of present without compromising ability of future generations to meet their own needs"
 - student sustainability presentation

c. SOPAC (Arshya Sharifian):

- Once people register – they usually vote but huge gap between able to register and actually registered
- UCSB ranked #1 in voter registration since 2006
- Sixth is ranked #1 among other colleges in voter reg
- Want to get it institutionalized – long term goal for not just our campus but other campuses as well
- Register so we can affect legislative that affect students such as fee increases and affirmative action
- Need to build UCSD's political capital
- More people registered = more political influence, more politicians address/ being aware of us
- 200,000 students and only 13% are registered to vote
- Motor Voter Bill: when go to DMV, if eligible to vote – can get app then
 - I. Caused huge spike in voter registration
- Bill SB397 passed so can register to vote online
