VII. Council Caucus/Items of Discussion

- a. Adrienne motioned to add to item, Cody seconded
- b. Diversity and environmental advocate positions
 - Discussed in rules- other college council have similar positions
 - Thinking of creating separate positions for these two
 - Have to do projects like senator positions
 - Sabrien: aren't there similar positions already? Yield to Kristian
 - Kristian: no we do not but sort of related to SAAC rep
 - Adrienne: instead of dissolving position, thinking of adding responsibilities to SAAC rep
 - Jeff: what kind of projects would advocates work on? Yielded to Kristian
 - Kristian: open ended – events, programs,etc
 - Jeff: not a lot of money in general unallocated so could be bad for budget
 - Emma: events toward social justice or in general diversity? Overlaps with culture committee
 - Adrienne: will overlap with culture committee but can work will greater UCSD community to promote diversity
 - Sabrien: instead of new project – can work with culture committee
 - Cody: diversity not just about culture, but also about women's, racial, LGBT issues among others – SAAC has project now? Yield to Linda
 - Linda: none so far
 - Adrienne: example – Triton Tide rep absorbed into spirit director
 - Emma: maybe could work with external office with A.S. – bring to sixth? Yield to Kristian
 - Kristian: external office = student advocacy not diversity
 - Shane: why are both position merged together?
 - Adrienne: they aren't – they are two separate positions
 - Sinou: can set limit for budget for programs that advocates would create – maybe could combine with other groups so we don't have to use council money

- Aaron: environmental advocate can work with Earth week – wouldn't cost any money – would just involve tabling – line b under position responsibilities not clear
- Savini: diversity – budget – combine with other groups
- Adrienne: trying to clarify line b in Rules
- Aaron: when would position take effect? Fall quarter? Yield to Adrienne
- Adrienne: thinking for fall appointments but would be a bit rushed- maybe could do straw poll
- Sabrien: what would position be for?
- Adrienne: awareness of students in Sixth college community and informing students about events in the world
- Sinou: change line b – research on workshops to promote diversity
- Aaron: position is too much with projects (because more UCSD issue not Sixth)– revamp SAAC rep
- Adrienne: straw poll about project idea- project appropriate, not appropriate, no project at all
 - a. Majority voted not appropriate
- Cody: just the fact that people do not understand position speaks to we need position – SAAC is informal committee so maybe can have SAAC/diversity rep
 - a. Jasmine motioned to extend Cody's speaking time, Sabrien seconded
- Emma: diversity advocate/external affairs/Michael Lam's report last week?
- Kristian: nothing to do with Michael Lam – Lam is from external affairs which focuses on lobbying, student advocacy
- Sabrien: like combining idea because SAAC rep goes to meetings and reports – so can go one step up
- Jeff: what projects did other people in this position do from other colleges? Yield to Kristian
- Kristian: not sure but will get back with specifics – did mural
- Nick: would people be interested in doing projects?
- Emma: really hard to get people to come out to social justice events – sub-committee for support
- Narciso: okay with overlapping UCSD and 6th – can have documentary screenings
- Savini: diversity advocate could work with CAT office to get programs approved as CAT events
- Linda: sub-committee of SAAC – can pull from other orgs such as BSU and APSA

- c. Sabrien Pabla, on behalf of Kati and Elaine Scott, Welcome Week, Requested: \$13,237.46 Funded: \$12,097.46 (5-0-1) from “Welcome Week” line-item
Increase from the line item in the approved pre-budget from \$9,000.00 to \$12,097.46 to compensate for increase in size of the incoming freshman class as well as tech and licensing fees for the movie. Funded approximately \$1000 less based on last year's post-budget.
